#### 3. Database

The membership list has been updated for 2023 memberships and the breeder's directory. Discussion of the pros and cons of charging a fee for the database entry occurred. Pam noted that charging a fee would actual cost CGA more in addition to the complications regarding record keeping. Jayne made a motion that we do not charge for the database at this time. #### 5. CGA Cashmere Goat Fiber & Conformation Evaluation Workshop 2023

Wendy shared the format of the program as both her and Peter will use the North American Cashmere Standard. Wendy and Peter will connect with Emily Pritt who has been hired by CGA to assist with the creation of the PowerPoint presentation.

Christine shared that an Eventbrite page was created for signups and has been shared on CGA's Facebook page. The board is encouraged to share this program with other groups that may be interested.

#### 6. Youth Show Showmanship

Mika created a collaborative outline that used both market and dairy goat showmanship guides and multiple score card guides as a reference in creating a CGA showmanship guide. Mika will reach out to the Monterey Extension Office to see if they will let CGA use their section of the guide. The board shared that pictures would be a good way to communicate techniques. Christine shared that there could be a call out on our social media pages for pictures. Kathy expressed concern over the technique of bracing animals in the show ring and whether this would be a preferred technique. Past CGA shows have not included this technique. Good discussion of the pros and cons of this technique occurred. More discussion will occur as Mika researches and develops CGA's Showmanship Guide.

# 7. Youth Goat Show Scholarship Application Approval

Elyse reported that one application has been received from the Adirondack Sheep & Wool and Arts Festival for a fiber goat show. (Both angora and cashmere goats are to be included.) \$250.00 has been requested for ribbons. David will be judging. Christine motioned to approve the \$250.00, Jayne seconded.

# 8. Adirondack Sheep & Wool and Arts Festival September 23rd & 24th

Kathy has been in touch with the coordinator for this show that has already established a fiber goat show with a recognized CGA goat judge. Kathy explained that the show's infrastructure

has already been created. Christine and Kathy will arrange a meeting with Rebecca, show administrator, to gather details that can then be communicated to the CGA membership ASAP.
