# 6. Langston Fiber Analysis Research & Fiber/Meat Goat Guide Updates (Danielle) Summary-

"Langston cashmere study- 25 farms have sent in samples. The total number of samples from those farms is around 930. David Shaw from New Zealand has sent is another 430 samples. So, just over 1350 samples will have been analyzed for the genomic association. The more samples the better. It would be great to get a few hundred more samples sent in. Samples can be clipped or combed. **Fiber due** 

**May 1st** before the grant runs out. Detailed instructions for collection and submission are on the website."

#### 8. American Sheep Industry Conference & American Goat Federation

Christine and Heidi presented on behalf of CGA at the annual AGF members meeting. The presentation included a brief history of CGA and the most recent initiatives.
