**Scoring Information:** 0 is a disqualifying number and is used only on Fiber Diameter (over 19 microns or “too coarse”), Uniformity (extremely inconsistent and variable in quality), or Length (less than a length of 1.24 inches in a relaxed state). The numerical score is a 1 for poor, a 2 for average, and a 3, which equals excellent. The judge has discretion in how to define the fiber, such as a micron estimate, text such as fine or very stylish, or very uniform or a score from 0 – 3. Conformation scores are all based on a 0 – 3. Individual scores are not weighted by the judge.
